






Average P. E. MINUTES offered in a week

Schools offering the highest weekly number of P. E. class MINUTES





The LEAs shown have the highest P.E. class enrollment ratios compared to total enrollment.



Average P. E. CLASS SIZE Presented by campus type



Percent of teachers licensed, certified, or endorsed by an accredited teacher preparation program to teach P. E.




18,751 of 28,275 P. E. teachers, or




Appropriate Equipment and Facilities
