



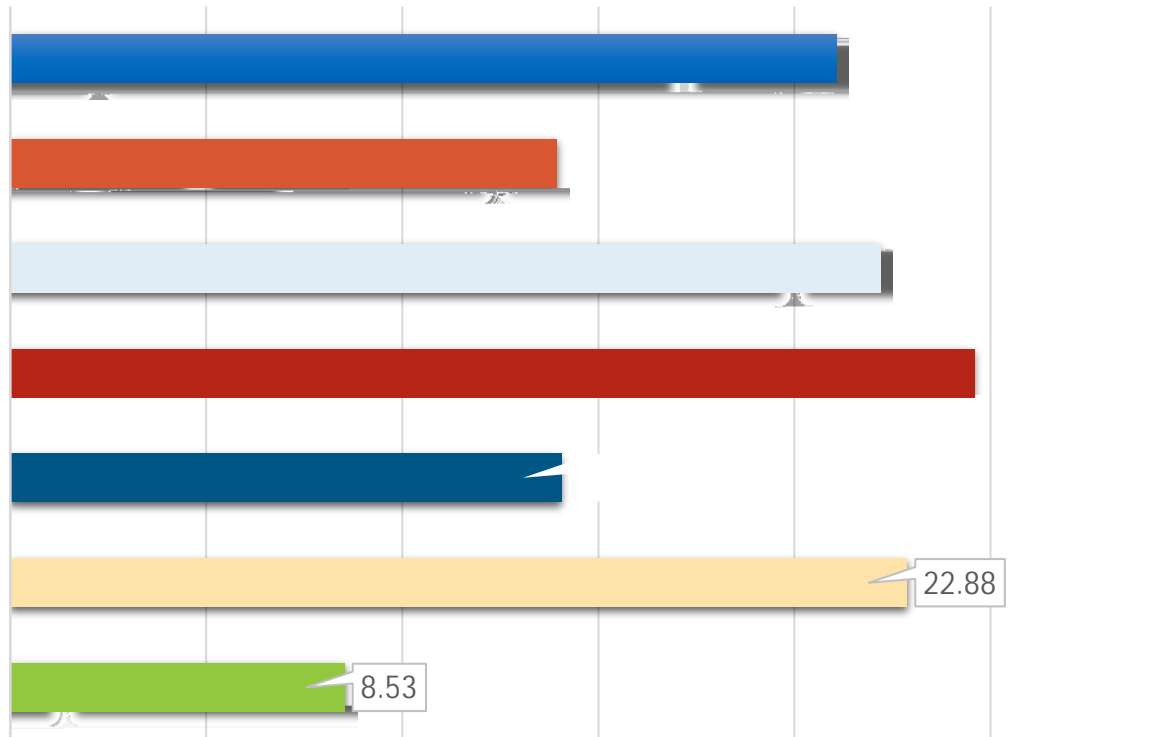

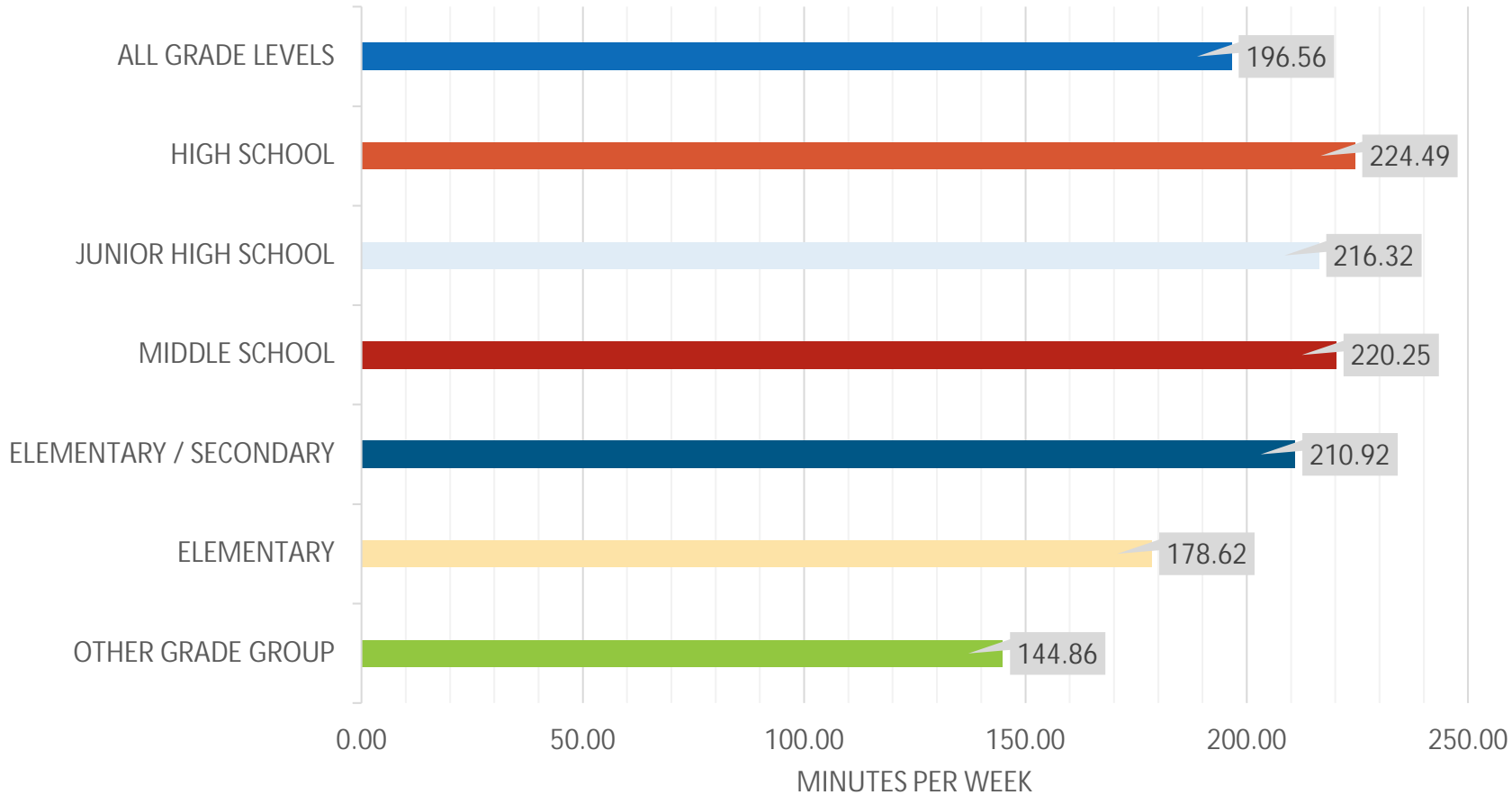

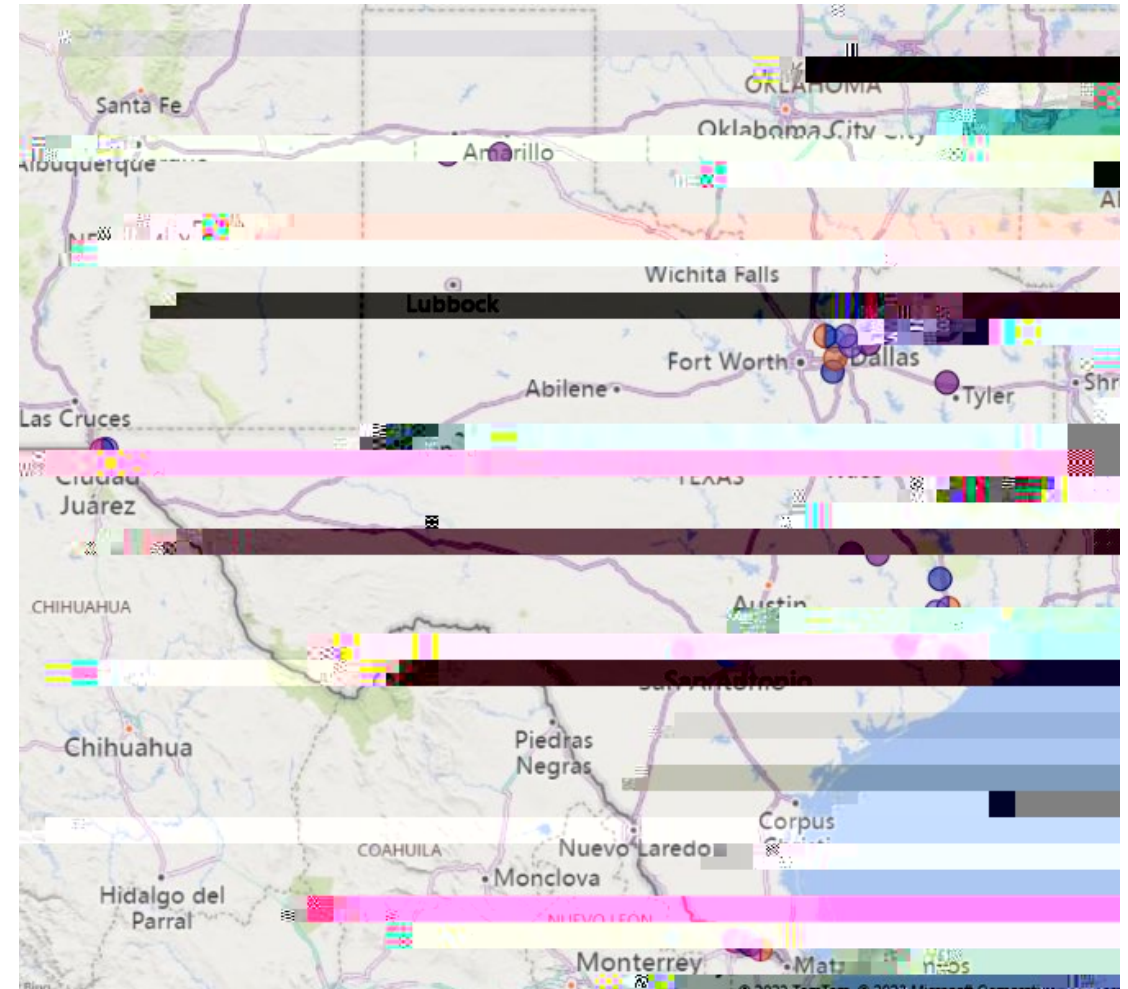

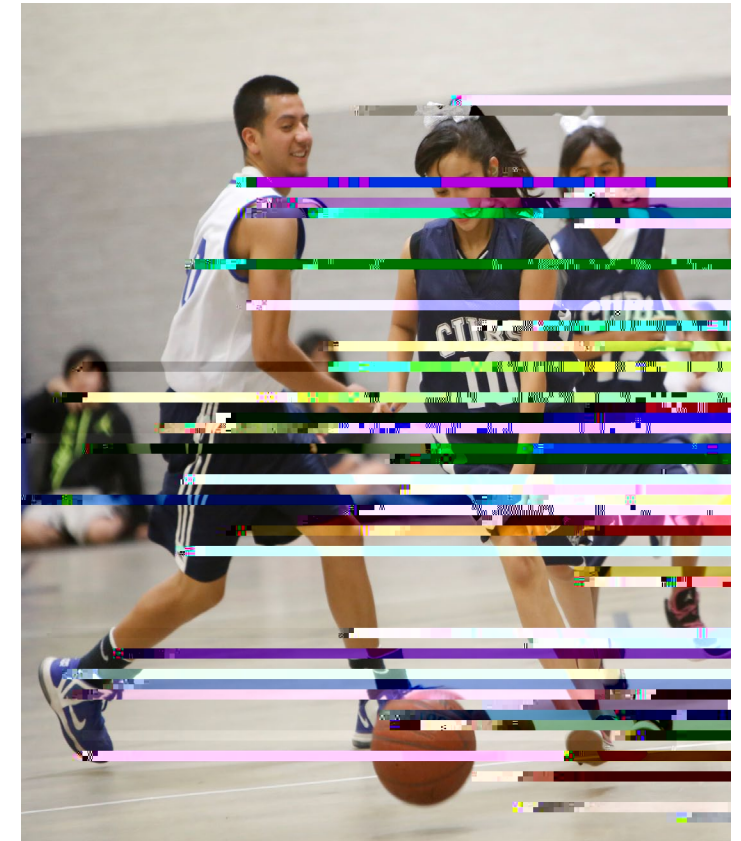
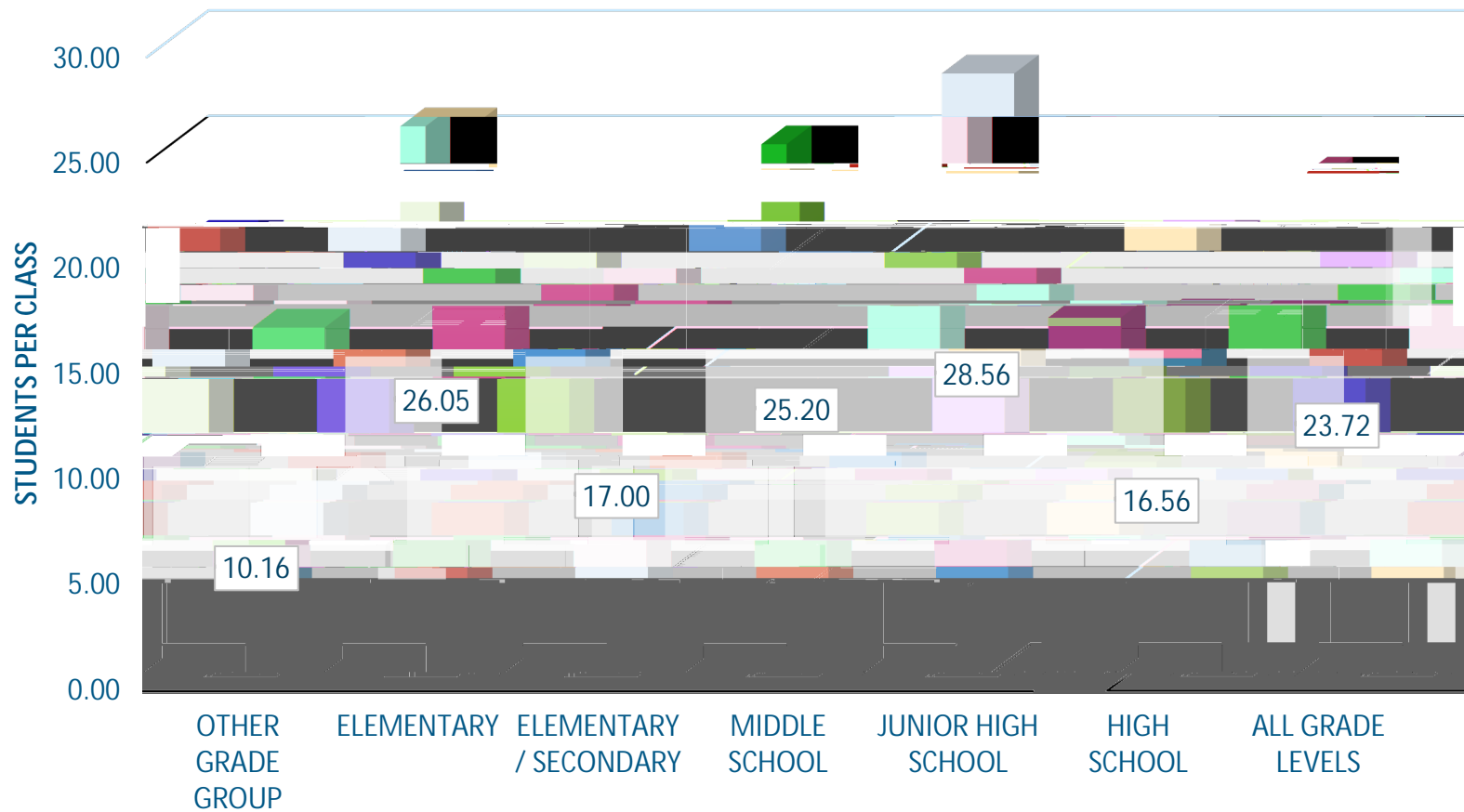

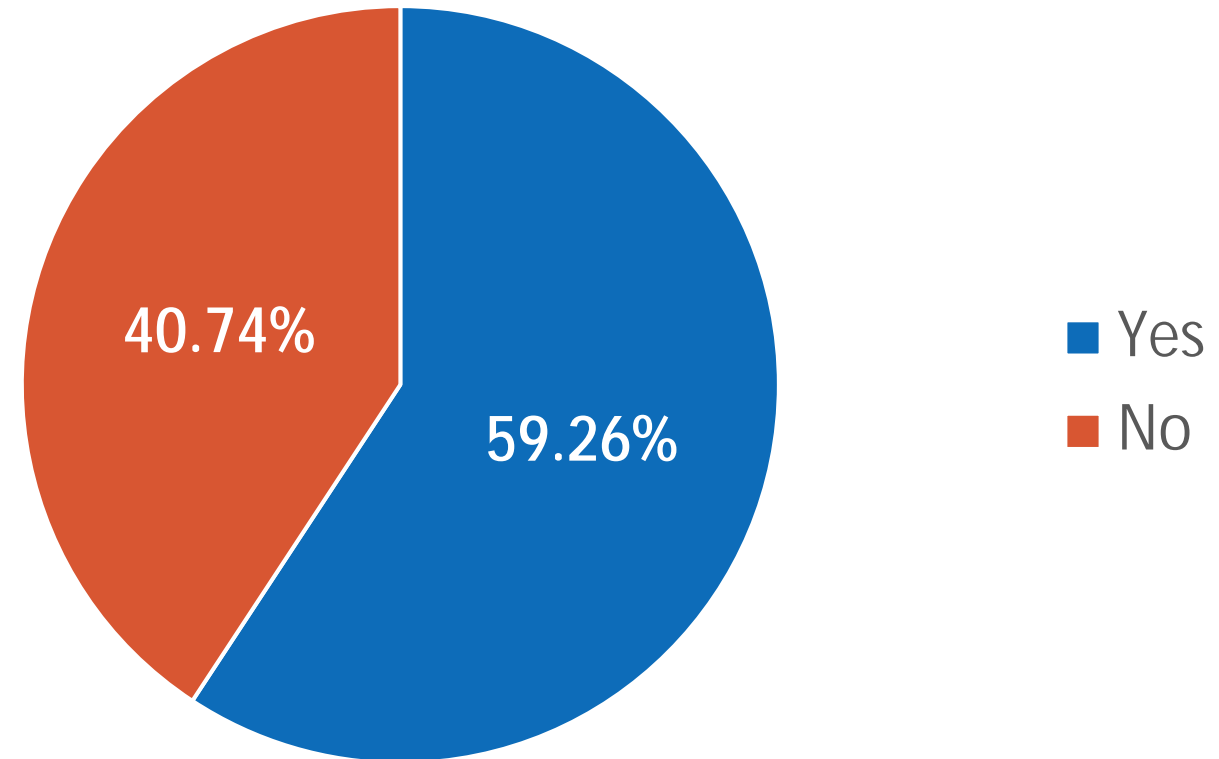
Percent of teachers licensed, certified, or endorsed by an accredited teacher preparation program to teach P. E.



18,751 of 28,275 P. E. teachers, or 59.26%, have standard certifications.

This percentage does not include teachers with generalist certifications who would also be certified to teach P. E. However, it does include teachers with standard, provisional, probationary, probationary extension, one-year, emergency, internship, non-renewable, and professional certificates.

Teachers licensed, certified, or endorsed by an accredited teacher preparation program to teach P. E.

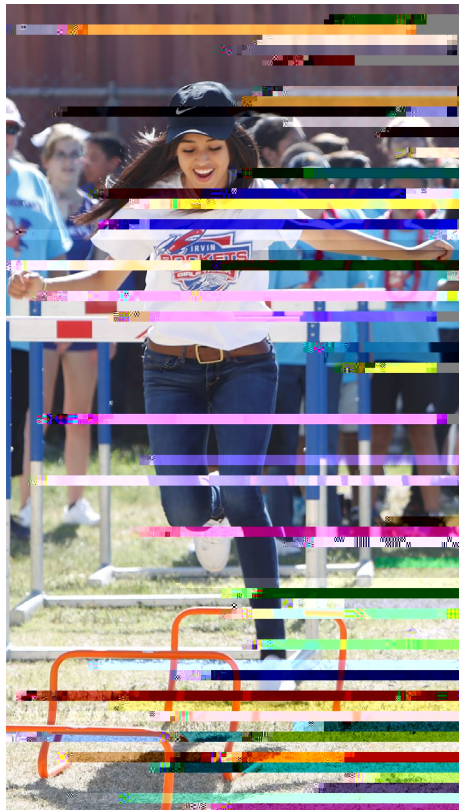

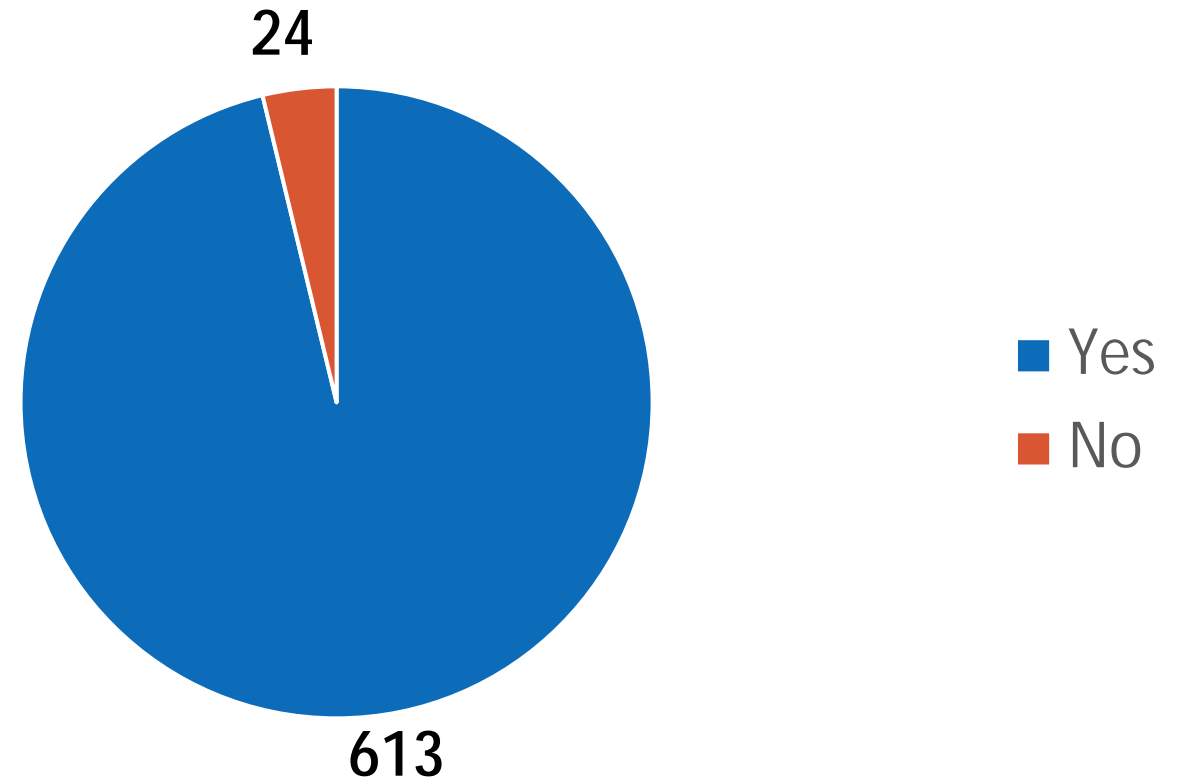


Appropriate Equipment and Facilities
